ORDINANCE NO. 17-14

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ALLEY DEDICATION PLAT FOR THE MAD RIVER & NKP RAILROAD SOCIETY, INC., IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Planning Commission, on June 4, 2014, has made a recommendation to this Council for approval of the alley dedication plat for the Mad River & NKP Railroad Society, Inc., of part of the southeast quarter of Section 25, formerly designated as York Township, and now the City of Bellevue, Sandusky County, Ohio, and being two parcels of 0.817 acre and 0.465 acre, respectively, more or less; and

WHEREAS, Bellevue City Council wishes to approve said alley dedication plat as aforesaid;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bellevue, Erie, Huron and Sandusky Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the alley dedication plat of the Mad River & NKP Railroad Society, Inc., as above described, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted, for the dedication of the alleys thereon specified, subject to and together with any easements appurtenant thereto. Said plat is found to meet the minimum requirements and regulations of the City of Bellevue.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Council of the City of Bellevue is hereby authorized and directed to affix her signature to the said Plat to indicate this Council's acceptance and approval thereof.

SECTION 3: For this dedication, the City will be responsible for improving and maintaining the alleys. Therefore, Section 1121.04 of the Bellevue Codified Ordinances relating to Subdivision Completion Bond and Form does not apply. This dedication shall be recorded upon Council approval and signatures by all parties, including the Bellevue City Engineer.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Bellevue, and for the further reason that it is necessary for this plat to be approved for the improvement and maintenance of these alleys as soon as possible.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
