RESOLUTION R-1-15

JOINT RESOLUTION AGREEING TO COOPERATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PARK IMPROVEMENTS WITH A RECYCLING THEME.

Re: Purchase of Fencing for the new City of Bellevue Dog Park

The proposed application is for \$5,000.00 with a \$10,000.00 local contribution, for a total project cost of \$15,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Board of the O.S.S. Solid Waste Management District, and the City of Bellevue Recreation Board, with the selection of the proposed project, desire to provide improved and increased outdoor recreational opportunities with a recycling theme to local residents; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the O.S.S. Solid Waste Management District to make funding available through Ottawa, Sandusky, and Seneca Counties for buying recycled materials made of recycled content;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Bellevue, Huron, Sandusky, and Erie Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the parties hereto agree to cooperate for the purposes of increasing and improving outdoor recreation opportunities with a recycling theme under the terms and conditions of the “2015 Grant Program” administered by the O.S.S. Solid Waste Management District if funding is awarded.

SECTION 2: That Marc Weisenberger, Recreation Director for the City of Bellevue Recreation Department, is authorized to make application for funding assistance from the “2015 Competitive Funding Grant Program,” and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3: That the City of Bellevue does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions, if any, of the O.S.S. Solid Waste Management District.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall go into full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
