

**MINUTES FOR THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 10, 2016**

The special City Council meeting of March 10, 2016 began at 7:00 p.m. President Smith thanked everyone for coming. After the Pledge of Allegiance, the roll was called. Council persons present: MR. BAKER, MR. FEUERSTEIN, MR. HILL, MR. MILLER, MRS. MISSLER, MISS NASCONE, AND MRS. OMMERT.

Mayor Strecker thanked everyone for coming and thanked Law Director, Mr. Wallingford, for all his efforts in getting the resolution ready.

President Smith stated that the purpose of the special meeting is to discuss Resolution R-3-16. The meeting will include discussion, reading of the resolution, consideration, and possible suspending of rules and passing. Rules of council will not allow any further legislation to be discussed at this meeting.

Bellevue Development Corporation Director, Mr. Fuhr, thanked everyone for attending the meeting tonight. He said that the State wants us to combine some of the City's CRA areas and expand on Area 10. Because a new business wants to start building on Monday morning, he would appreciate it if Council would consider suspending the rules, having all three readings, and if possible, having it passed tonight.

The resolution was discussed and all questions were answered by Mr. Fuhr and Mr. Wallingford.

President Smith thanked Mr. Fuhr, Mr. Wallingford and the clerk for all their time and work getting the resolution ready. He then turned the time over to Law Director, Mr. Wallingford, for tonight's legislation.

LEGISLATION:

Resolution R-3-16 was given its first reading: A RESOLUTION FURTHER CONFIRMING AND CLARIFYING ORDINANCE NO. 22-15 AND RESOLUTION R-2-16 ESTABLISHING A CITY-WIDE COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AND EXPANDING AND AMENDING EXISTING COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREAS OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTIONS 3735.65 THROUGH 3735.70, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Motion was made by Mr. Miller to suspend the rules and give Resolution R-3-16 its second and third readings by title only. The motion was seconded by Mr. Feuerstein. A vote was taken. All were in favor.

Resolution R-3-16 was given its second and third readings by title only: A RESOLUTION FURTHER CONFIRMING AND CLARIFYING ORDINANCE NO. 22-15 AND RESOLUTION R-2-16 ESTABLISHING A CITY-WIDE COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AND EXPANDING AND AMENDING EXISTING COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREAS OF

THE CITY OF BELLEVUE PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTIONS 3735.65 THROUGH 3735.70, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Motion was made by Mr. Feuerstein to adopt Resolution R-3-16 and as an emergency. It was seconded by Mrs. Missler. A vote was taken. Motion passed by a vote of 7-0 and as an emergency.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Baker and seconded by Mrs. Missler. All were in favor.
