**RESOLUTION R-5-16**

**A RESOLUTION DETERMINING EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICE FOR THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Bellevue is empowered to determine emergency management service for the City, pursuant to OAC 4501:3-3; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Bellevue has determined the following: To contract with the Huron County Emergency Management Agency for emergency management services, at a cost of \$.25 per person, based on the population of the political subdivision for the period of July 1, 2016, to June 30, 2017. This contract will be renewable on an annual basis. Additionally, the Council of the City of Bellevue has selected the following individual as their contact person to work with the Huron County Emergency Management Agency and to serve on the Huron County Emergency Management Advisory Board effective July 1, 2016: MICHAEL E. LANTZ, SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR, 3000 Seneca Industrial Parkway, Bellevue, Ohio 44811, (419) 484-8400; and

**WHEREAS**, the actions of the Council of the City of Bellevue shall be relayed to the Huron County Emergency Management Agency, 255-B Shady Lane Drive, Norwalk, Ohio 44857, by this original resolution;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the foregoing resolution was adopted and all actions and deliberations of the Council of the City of Bellevue relating thereto were conducted in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bellevue and for the further specific reason that time is of the essence for this resolution and the contract for emergency management service to be in effect by July 1, 2016.

**WHEREFORE**, this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

## RESOLUTION R-6-16

**A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 5705.03 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE REQUESTING THE SANDUSKY COUNTY AUDITOR, THE HURON COUNTY AUDITOR AND THE ERIE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY TO THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, OHIO, THE CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, OHIO, IN SANDUSKY COUNTY, HURON COUNTY AND ERIE COUNTY, AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY A RENEWAL ONE (1) MILL TAX LEVY FOR PARKS AND RECREATION PURPOSES AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 5705.19 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Bellevue has determined that it is necessary to submit to the voters at the election to be held November 8, 2016, the question for a renewal levy for parks and recreation purposes for the tax years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021, to be collected in calendar years 2018 through 2022, inclusive.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Bellevue, Huron, Sandusky, and Erie Counties, Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Council of the City of Bellevue, Ohio hereby requests that the Sandusky County Auditor and the Huron County Auditor and the Erie County Auditor certify to the Council of the City of Bellevue the total current tax valuation of the City of Bellevue, Ohio, Sandusky County, Huron County and Erie County, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal (1) mill tax levy for parks and recreation purposes.

**SECTION 2:** That the Council of the City of Bellevue hereby requests permission to levy outside the ten mill limitation for the purpose stated above.

**SECTION 3:** That the Clerk of City Council be and she hereby is authorized and directed to immediately certify a copy of this Resolution to the Sandusky County Auditor and/or Huron County Auditor and/or Erie County Auditor, in order to obtain the information necessary to submit the renewal tax levy to the electors of said City at the election to be held November 8, 2016.

**SECTION 4:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bellevue, and for the further specific reason that the matter needs to be approved and filed by August 10, 2016 to be placed on the November ballot.

**WHEREFORE**, this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
