**RESOLUTION R-9-16**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE FILING OF AN APPLICATION AND THE OBLIGATION OF NECESSARY FUNDS TO COMPLETE A NATURE WORKS PROJECT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Federal Land and Water conservation Fund Program and/or the State of Ohio Nature Works Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bellevue, through its Recreation Department, desires financial assistance under the Nature Works Program;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Bellevue, Huron, Sandusky, and Erie Counties, Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That the City of Bellevue City Council approves filing an application for financial assistance.

**SECTION 2:** That Marc Weisenberger, Recreation Director for the City of Bellevue, is authorized and directed to execute all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

**SECTION 3:** That the City of Bellevue, on behalf of its Recreation Board, does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Nature Works Program.

**SECTION 4:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bellevue, and for the further specific reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant as soon as possible in order to be of the most benefit to the community and to comply with program deadlines.

**WHEREFORE**, that this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

**ORDINANCE NO. 8-16**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A LABOR CONTRACT WITH AFSCME, GROUP 1, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Bellevue has previously contracted with the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, the labor union representing the Bellevue Municipal Employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the current contract expired March 31, 2016, and a new three-year contract has been negotiated by the union and city officials, to be effective as of April 1, 2016 and to run through March 31, 2019, with a potential additional one year renewal to March 31, 2020, specifically with Group 1 employees of the deemed bargaining unit, to-wit, Service, Maintenance, and Clerical Employees covered by the previous AFSCME Group 1 contract;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** By the Council of the city of Bellevue, Huron, Sandusky and Erie Counties, Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That the Council of the City of Bellevue hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Safety-Service Director to enter into the new labor contract attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth and to sign the same on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 2:** The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to make payments to the employees covered by this contract and to draw his warrant or warrants and take any other actions necessary or appropriate to comply with the new agreement.

**SECTION 3:** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Bellevue, and for the further specific reason that the old contract has expired and the parties desire to enter into the new contract as soon as possible.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
