ORDINANCE NO. 15-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A LABOR CONTRACT WITH AFSCME, GROUPS 2 AND 3, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of Bellevue has previously contracted with the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, the labor union representing the Bellevue Municipal Employees; and

WHEREAS, the current contract expired April 30, 2016, and a new three-year contract has been negotiated by the union and city officials, to be effective as of May 1, 2016, and to run through April 30, 2019, specifically with Group 2 and Group 3 employees of the deemed bargaining unit, to-wit, said groups including all City Fire Fighters and Lieutenants, which are covered by the previous AFSCME Group 2 and Group 3 contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Council of the City of Bellevue, Huron, Sandusky and Erie Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Bellevue hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Safety-Service Director to enter into the new labor contract attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth and to sign the same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to make payments to the employees covered by this contract and to draw his warrant or warrants and take any other actions necessary or appropriate to comply with the new agreement.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Bellevue, and for the further specific reason that the new contract is set to take effect retroactively as of May 1, 2016, and the parties desire to enter into the new contract as soon as possible for this to take place.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 16-16

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF
TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES,
AT NO COST TO THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City has determined the need for the described project: Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to bridge load rating calculations, scour assessments, bridge inspections, and fracture critical plan development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Council of the City of Bellevue, Erie, Huron and Sandusky Counties, Ohio, by a two-thirds vote of its members:

SECTION 1: That being in the public interest, the City of Bellevue gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above-described project.

SECTION 2: The City of Bellevue shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract (Exhibit A).

The City of Bellevue agrees to pay 100 percent of the cost of those features which are not included in Exhibit A.

SECTION 3: The City of Bellevue agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be made available in accordance with current state and federal regulations.

SECTION 4: The Safety-Service Director of said City of Bellevue, is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Bellevue to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation which is necessary to complete the above-described project.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bellevue, and for the specific reason that time is of the essence in applying for the Bridge Inspection Program Services to assure that Bellevue is in full compliance with FHWA's bridge metrics.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
